
**Photograph 180.** Structure 374, 85 Linden Street, Mount Carmel St. Anthony School. A two-story brick school, constructed c. 1950.




**Photograph 192.** Structure 409, 87 rear South Broadway, YWCA building. A three-story brick structure, constructed c.1950.



**Photograph 199.** Structure 419, 104 South Broadway, former Saunders Trades Schools. A three-story brick school, constructed c.1900.




**Photograph 200.** Structure 424, 14 Guion Street. A four-story brick masonry apartment building, constructed c.1900.




