## Yonkers redevelopment proposal wins planning award

The New York metropolitan chapter of the American Planning Association will honor Yonkers Mayor Phil Amicone, Groundwork Yonkers, Scenic Hudson and Struever Fidelco Cappelli for a plan to uncover the Saw Mill River.

Tonight's ceremony at the Museum of the City of New York will bestow the William H. Whyte Award on the two non-profit organizations, the development partnership and the city for a plan to transform Larkin Plaza into a river walkway.

Although Struever Fidelco Cappelli proposes to demolish Larkin Plaza and uncover the river as part of a massive redevelopment proposal for downtown, the city council has not approved such plans.
